Midwest Regional Collegiate Cyber Defense Competition

Be part of the action as top cybersecurity students from the Midwest build and defend their mock production business infrastructure from unknown threats. Students, in teams of eight, will fend off "hackers," while network enhancement and upgrade challenges are randomly deployed. Teams will be judged on overall performance, score and abilities throughout the event.

This competition is the first of its kind to create a realistic corporate administration and security experience – giving the competitors a chance to compare their education and training against their peers and the real-world challenges that await.

Competition Overview

Over the course of two days, more than 100 student competitors will work to detect and respond to outside threats, including cyber-attacks, while maintaining availability of existing network services such as mail and web servers, respond to business requests such as the addition or removal of additional services, and balance security against varying business needs.

The competition is designed to test each student team's ability to secure a networked computer system while maintaining standard business functionality. Each team begins the competition with an identical set of hardware and software and is scored on their ability to detect and respond to outside threats while maintaining existing services.

The Competitors

Each team consists of eight full-time students from two-year and fouryear colleges and universities from Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Michigan, Minnesota, Ohio, Missouri, and Wisconsin. The students range in knowledge and experience but are all studying to be the next generation of cybersecurity specialists.
